

RESULTS OF DEPLOYMENT



- DUCK HUNT WAS THE MOST POPULAR GAME

- BOTH PARENTS SPENT TIME TEACHING THE CHILDREN WITH THE HELP OF THE TVC

PLAY AS LEARNING

(RELATIVELY) OPEN HOMES



COMPARED TO THE REST OF BANGALORE, HOMES IN THIS AREA ARE RELATIVELY MORE OPEN. WHEN THE TVC WAS DEPLOYED, EVERYONE FROM THE NEIGHBOURHOOD RUSHED INTO THE HOUSE WITHOUT ANY INHIBITION. HOWEVER, NO ONE (ASIDE FROM THE FATHER'S FRIENDS) WAS PERMITTED TO RETURN TO USE THE DEVICE.
